



COOPERS STADIUM CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

The following Conditions of Entry will apply to all Coopers Stadium patrons. These conditions should be read in conjunction with the ticket conditions appearing on each ticket that apply to all ticket holders.

In addition they should be read in conjunction with Football Federation of Australia – A-League Terms of Admission and the Spectator Code of Behaviour, both available at www.coopersstadium.com.au and on the notice boards at the Manton and Holden Street entries.

Refusal of Entry

For the comfort, safety and enjoyment of all patrons, Coopers Stadium management reserves the right to:

- Refuse entry to any person deemed to be intoxicated and / or disorderly;
- Refuse entry to any unauthorised persons;
- Refuse entry of items which have the potential to cause injury or public nuisance (i.e., large flags / banners, musical instruments etc).

General Conditions

- All patrons may be subject to personal and / or bag searches before entering the venue.
- Persons gaining unauthorised access to Coopers Stadium and / or the venue's pitch may be liable for prosecution.
- Patrons who cause a disturbance, or refuse to comply with lawful requests made by Coopers Stadium staff will be evicted.
- Security cameras operate at this Stadium and patrons may be filmed / photographed.
- Alcoholic beverages cannot be taken into or from Coopers Stadium.
- Smoking is not permitted within Coopers Stadium but smoking is permitted in designated areas outside the gates.
- Patrons wishing to bring personal items into Coopers Stadium do so at their own risk. Coopers Stadium will not be held responsible for any damages to, loss or theft of a patron's personal property.
- Patrons must refrain from using foul or abusive language and from making racial or threatening remarks or gestures.
- Some areas of Coopers Stadium are exposed to direct sunlight and heat. Patrons are required to take appropriate care for their sun protection and hydration.
- Seats retract automatically. Check your seat before you sit down.
- Some sporting and other activities are dangerous. Patrons viewing or participating in such activities do so at their own risk.

Restricted / Prohibited Items

- Glass, Bottles, Cans, Coolers, Iceboxes or Eskies
- Knives or other dangerous weapons
- Flares, Fireworks, Explosives or Smoke Bombs
- Laser Pointers
- Alcohol or Illegal Substances
- Signs, Banners or Flags of non-participating teams / countries
- Flags and Banners must NOT exceed 1 m in length and 1m in depth without prior Stadium management approval
- Poles, other than wood or plastic or in excess of 1.6m in length and NO more than 0.75cm in diameter
- Animals (except official guide or hearing dogs)
- Bicycles, Frisbees, Kites, Bicycles, Scooters, Skateboards, Skates (including In-line Skates)
- Professional Cameras, Audio Equipment or Video Cameras
- Not to wear or otherwise display racial, political or signage or logos that may be offensive
- Chopped or Shredded Paper which can be used as Confetti
- Any item that the Stadium management considers inappropriate
- STADIUM MANAGEMENT RESERVES THE RIGHT TO CONFISCATE THE ABOVE ITEMS

Liquor Licencing

All persons entering Coopers Stadium are advised that:

- They are entering licenced premises;
- Intoxicated persons will not be permitted to enter;
- Persons in possession of liquor will not be permitted to enter;
- Checking procedures will apply to prevent persons possessing liquor from entering;
- Intoxicated persons will be removed from the premises;
- It is an offence for minors to purchase and consume liquor;
- It is an offence to purchase liquor for, or supply liquor to, minors.

The Stadium management can refuse entry or remove people if they:

1. Do not obey the above rules
2. Are disruptive
3. Interfere with the enjoyment, comfort and safety of others
4. Refuse to allow any inspection of clothing, baggage, containers or other items in their possession.
5. Have a lost, stolen, counterfeit, damaged or unreadable ticket
